In order to promote this beautiful Japanese word, we will use the word **Kyosai** also in


English context.





# **Great East Japan Earth Quake, 11th of Mar. 2011.**

Sufferer visiting activities were jointly conducted by member co-ops of CO-OP Kyosai nationwide and CO-OP Kyosai.



Activities are to create a place for members to learn from each other







- 1) Lectures and study sessions for co-op members
- 2) personal consultation meetings
- 3) Activities in response to requests from the local communities
- 4) Senryu (Japanese short and satirical poem) project
- 5) Others (participation in co-op festivals, Exhibition of a LPA booth at a co-op festival, etc.)

More than 30,000 members have participated in the life-planning activities nationwide every year.

In FY2020, however, the activities were halted due to the pandemic, and the number of participants dropped to 36% of the previous year.

In FY2021, with the efforts and ingenuity of the LPA, activities are being revived with the use of online meeting and infection prevention measures.

We hold study sessions and lectures on a variety of topics and provide personal consultations for reviewing insurance coverage.

Examples of themes

- -Review of insurance coverage/ family finances
- -Life- planning
- -Social security/ Tax/ Finance
- -Education for children

- -Disaster prevention, etc.
- -Health promotion has been added as one of the themes in CO-OP Kyosai Long-term Vision 2030

## Activity: Exciting Business Management

by learning how to earn money with their friends, students will learn about money in their daily lives and future life- plans.





LPA members nationwide are striving for keeping our activities going!

We are making daily efforts to keep our activities going by challenging ourselves online, creating learning videos, and creating learning spaces under infection prevention measures.

The number of participants is on the rise in 2021.

LPA members continue to study to update their own knowledge even when they are not active. They are also taking on new challenges, such as taking lectures to organize study sessions online. We have wonderful fellows who have never stopped learning throughout the country.





This grants program started in 2012.

It is designed to support activities conducted in collaboration between co-ops and local organizations.

Activities that meet the following 3 themes are eligible for subsidies:

- 1. Activities that protect people's livelihoods and contribute to solving their problems
- 2. Activities that protect people's lives and enable them to live true to themselves
- 3. Activities that women and children can feel lively

To date, we have provided grants of over 200 million JPY (1.8 million USD) to a total of 386 activities.

The grants are celebrating 10 full years in Mar. 2022. We are planning to hold a commemorative project this year (actually, they are the same age as Co-suke, CO-OP Kyosai official character!).

In this anniversary project, we are planning to collect the voices of the screening committee members and episodes from the grantee organizations.

## **Ehime Medical Co-op Rainbow Farm**

Creating a place for local residents to belong through agricultural work at the farm.

Each person can make use of his or her own strengths and enjoy activities with friends, leading to the prevention of frailty and mental health of the elderly. In one case, a person who tended to stay at home started to go outside because of this farm. There is also a lot of interaction with local kindergarten children. Vegetables from the fields are sold in the medical coop (hospital) and are appreciated by the local people.

The subsidy was used to improve the infrastructure to make it easier for everyone to work.





Looking back over the past 10 years, the grants will be relaunched as a new system in FY2022.

Grants to Promote Mutual Support in Communities will be re-launched with a scheme that further encourages the collaboration between co-ops and community groups, which has always been important to us.

We expect that collaboration among different organizations, and sharing their thoughts and utilizing each member's strengths will produce results that cannot be achieved independently.
